BY THE COMMISSION:

O P I N I O N

In the above entitled application Paradise Valley Sanitarium and Hospital, a corporation, requests the Commission to grant to it a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation between Paradise Valley Sanitarium and Hospital and the intersection of Second and National Streets in National City, San Diego County, and intermediate points.

An examination of the map attached to the application and marked Exhibit "C" indicates that the termini and entire route of the proposed operation are within the corporate limits of National City. This fact has been verified by counsel for applicant. The application will be dismissed because Section 24 of the Public Utilities Act excludes from the term "passenger stage corporations" those "...whose operations are exclusively within the limits of a single incorporated city, town or city and county,....". The Commission's records do not disclose that applicant is conducting any other passenger transportation service.
