FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Bancroft Avenue in San Francisco, at the location described in the First Supplemental application. Said street is not open or traveled at the point of crossing and this order shall not be considered as authority for such opening. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
