NINTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 30767, as amended, in this proceeding, authorized J. P. Spaenhower to transport property for Western States Grocery Company and Safeway Stores, Inc. from Stockton and Tracy to designated central California points until November 5, 1944, at rates less than those established as minima. By supplemental application a one-year extension of the authority is sought.

The verified application shows that the character of applicant's operation has not changed since the outstanding authority was granted and that although applicant's operating costs have increased somewhat he still enjoys a substantial profit from the rates sought to be continued.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the supplemental application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the authority granted J. P. Spaenhower by Decision No. 30767, as amended, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby extended to November 5, 1945, unless sooner

changed, canceled or further extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective November 5, 1944.
