ORDER REOPENING PROCEEDING FOR
FURTHER HEARING

The Commission having reserved the right by Decision No. 36242, rendered herein March 23, 1943, to make such further order in this proceeding as in its discretion might seem just and proper; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) That Case No. 4672 be and it hereby is reopened for the purpose of determining whether the rates and charges presently maintained by respondent Vallejo Bus Company are unjust, unreasonable, discriminatory or preferential, and prescribing the just, reasonable, sufficient and proper rates and charges to be established and maintained by said respondent; and more particularly, for the purpose of determining whether the rates and charges prescribed by said Decision No. 36242 should be in any way modified or reduced.

(2) That a hearing in said reopened proceeding shall be had before Commissioners Sachse and Rowell, or an examiner designated by them or by the Commission, to take evidence in their behalf, in the City Hall, Vallejo, California, on the 8th day of November, 1944, at 10:00 A.M.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon each of the parties to said proceeding, not less than five (5) days before the time herein fixed for said hearing.
