## ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across 26th Street in Oakland, Alameda County, at the location described in the application. Said Street is unimproved and not traveled at the point of crossing, and this order shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of 26th Street across said spur track. Nor shall this order be construed as authorizing the crossing of said spur with a track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway in 26th Street. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
