BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The United States of America is authorized to construct a road to serve the Fairfield-Suisun Airport across a track of Sacramento Northern Railway Company near Fairfield, Solano County, at the location described in the application, said crossing is not for use by the general public and no Crossing No. is assigned at this time. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance cost. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than four per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. O. 75-B).

Upon completion, private farm crossing in immediate vicinity shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,

necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
