OPINION AND ORDER

By this application Carl J. Stanley and Justus E. Kirkman, copartners conducting public utility warehouse operations at Chowchilla as Chowchilla Warehouse Company, seek authority to lease their utility property to a copartnership composed of Stanley, Kirkman and J. W. Gallarda, Jr.

The verified application shows that public utility warehouse operations are also being conducted at Chowchilla by Stanley, Kirkman and Gallarda under the name of Gallarda Grain and Milling Company; and that the proposed consolidation of these operations with Chowchilla Warehouse Company's would not result in any change in rates, or in service to the public.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Carl J. Stanley and Justus E. Kirkman, copartners doing business as Chowchilla Warehouse Company, be and they are hereby authorized to lease the public utility warehouse property involved in this proceeding to Carl J. Stanley, Justus E. Kirkham and J. W. Gallarda, Jr., copartners doing business as Gallarda Grain and Milling Company, and to execute a lease; said

lease to be in substantially the same form as the lease attached to the application, as amended.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that immediately upon the leasing of the property involved Carl J. Stanley, Justus E. Kirkman and J. W. Gallarda, Jr., shall, on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and to the public, supplement or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission in so far as they name rates, rules and regulations governing warehouse operations of Carl J. Stanley and Justus E. Kirkman, doing business as Chowchilla Warehouse Company, to show that they have withdrawn and canceled and that Carl J. Stanley, Justus E. Kirkman and J. W. Gallarda, Jr., doing business as Gallarda Grain and Milling Company, have concurrently adopted or established as their own said rates, rules and regulations; and that the tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall in all other respects comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof:
