BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The People of the State of California, on relation of the
Department of Public Works, are authorized to construct a State
Highway (III-Pla-37-Aub) at separated grades over the tracks of
Southern Pacific Company near the easterly city limits of the City
of Auburn, County of Placer, State of California, at the location as
shown by map, Exhibit "A", attached to the application, to be iden-
tified as Crossing No. A-125.1-A. Construction and maintenance ex-
pense shall be in accordance with an agreement to be entered into
between the parties relative to said construction and maintenance,
a copy of which shall be filed with the Commission prior to the com-
mencement of construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Com-
mission will, after hearing, determine the division of cost. Plans
of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company shall be filed
prior to commencement of construction. Clearances shall conform to
the provisions of General Order 26-C.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order
applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authoriza-
tion shall become void if not exercised within two years from the
conclusion of the war unless time be extended or if conditions are
not complied with.

This order shall be effective immediately.
