BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The People of the State of California on relation of the Department of Public Works are authorized to construct a State highway (III-Sac-3-B) at separated grades under the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company at Swanston, in the County of Sacramento, State of California, at the location as shown by map, Exhibit "A," attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. A-92.9-B. Construction and maintenance expense shall be in accordance with agreement to be entered into between the parties relative to said construction and maintenance, a copy of which shall be filed with the Commission prior to the commencement of construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will, after hearing, determine the division of cost. Plans of said crossing approved by the Southern Pacific Company shall be filed prior to commencement of construction. Clearance shall conform to the provisions of G.O. No. 26-C.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years from the conclusion of the war, unless time is extended or if conditions are

not complied with.

This Order shall be effective immediately.
