ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In Eighth Supplemental Application No. 24432 San Bernardino Valley Transit Company, a corporation, requested authority to abandon operations over Tippecanoe Street between its intersection with Third Street and its terminus south of Cardiff Avenue, and in lieu thereof to extend operations along Third Street from its intersection with Tippecanoe Street to Victoria Street. A public hearing was had thereon and the matter was submitted. Thereafter, the proceeding was reopened for further hearing which was had, and the matter re-submitted. Under the date of October 26, 1944 counsel (1) for applicant has requested that the application be dismissed.

(1) By Decision No. 37279 in Application No. 26157, the Commission authorized Air Service Transit, Inc. to acquire a passenger stage operative right from F. M. Snell over and along Third Street between San Bernardino and East Highlands, which includes that portion of East Third Street between Tippecanoe Street and Victoria Street. Air Service Transit, Inc. is under the same management and control as San Bernardino Valley Transit Company.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Eighth Supplemental Application No. 24432 be and it is hereby dismissed.
