BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the construction at grade of an industrial spur track across McKendrie Street, in the City of San Jose, County of Santa Clara, State of California. Application No. 26463

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across McKendrie Street in San Jose, Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application. McKendrie is not traveled at the point of crossing and this order shall not be deemed authority for the opening of said street across said track. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
