BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct a crossing of Road II-Sis-3-A at separated grades over the main line track of Southern Pacific Company near Black Butte, Siskiyou County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. C-343.5-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties, copy of which, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction. Upon completion, Crossing No. C-344.8-A, known as the Weed Overhead, shall be abandoned and closed to public use.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years after termination of the existing National Emergency, or if conditions are not complied with. This order shall be effective immediately.
