ORDER

In this application California, Shasta and Eastern Railway Company requests authority to sell to Shasta County for highway purposes a portion of its right of way and its bridge across the Sacramento River. This railroad was originally constructed as a lumber road, but under authority granted by this Commission in Application No. 13483 has suspended operations since 1927. The highway which the County proposes will largely serve the same purpose as the railroad, and the deed contains a reversionary clause in the event of abandonment for highway purposes.

Good Cause Appearing, IT IS ORDERED that California, Shasta and Eastern Railway Company is authorized to execute and deliver to the County of Shasta a deed covering a portion of its right of way as described in the copy of deed attached to and made a part of the application under terms substantially in accordance with such deed, and to sell to said County applicant's bridge across the Sacramento River, all subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall within thirty days thereafter notify this Commission in writing of the completion of the property transfer herein authorized.
- (2) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
