BY THE COMMISSION:

## O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California  
 is authorized to construct a Naval Access road at separated grades,  
 under the main line track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway  
 Company near Stockton, San Joaquin County, at the location as shown  
 by map (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as  
 Crossing No. 2-1123.6-3. Upon completion, jurisdiction over said  
 access road is to be assumed by San Joaquin County, and said county  
 is agreeable to assuming maintenance thereof. Construction and  
 maintenance expense shall be in accordance with an agreement entered  
 into between the parties relative to the construction and maintenance  
 of said crossing. Copy of said agreement together with plans of said  
 crossing approved by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company  
 shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order  
 applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authoriza-  
 tion shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time  
 be extended or if conditions are not complied with. This order shall  
 be effective immediately.
