O P I N I O N

Glenn Wright and A. R. Wright, doing business as Hunter Liggett Stages, were authorized by Decision No. 36659, in Application No. 24798, to operate a passenger stage service between San Miguel and King City and intermediate points, via Bradley, Camp Pleyto and Camp Jolon (Hunter-Liggett Military Reservation), subject to certain restrictions. This service was designed to meet the needs of military forces between Hunter-Liggett Military Reservation and San Miguel, Bradley and King City. Such need exists only when such forces are stationed at this reservation.

As of August 1, 1944, all troops have been transferred from the reservation and the need for applicants' service was temporarily suspended. Decision No. 37322, in Application No. 26301, authorized applicants to temporarily suspend this service until December 15, 1944. Applicants now request the Commission to authorize a continuance of this suspension of service for an additional period of one year. They assert that the Army Transportation Officer of the 9th Zone Transportation Office has requested them to remain in a position to re-establish their service when the reservation is re-activated.

It appears that the reasons as set forth by applicants are sufficient to justify authorization of a continued suspension of their service until public necessity requires its re-establishment, and the application will be granted on such basis. This matter does not require a public hearing.

O R D E R

The application herein having been fully considered, and the Commission being fully informed therein:

IT IS ORDERED that Glenn Wright and A. R. Wright be, and they hereby are, authorized to continue suspension of the operation of the passenger stage service between the points certificated by Decision No. 36659 until December 31, 1945; provided, however, that at any time prior to said date, applicants shall resume the operation of said service when public convenience and necessity so require. In the exercise of the authority herein granted, the following service regulations shall be observed:

1. Applicants shall immediately and on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public supplement their tariffs and time tables to indicate the suspension of service herein authorized.
2. The Commission and the public shall be notified of resumption of service not less than one day prior thereto by the filing of appropriate tariffs and time tables.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
