SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 36961, of March 28, 1944, in this proceeding, A.B.C. Transfer & Storage Company, Inc., a public utility warehouseman at San Francisco, was authorized to increase its warehouse floor space by 75,000 square feet for the storage of property for the United States Government and property for transshipment which requires storage because of a lack of available vessel space. This authority will expire December 31, 1944. Its extension for the duration of the war and six months thereafter, or until December 31, 1945, is now sought.

The verified application shows that the conditions which obtained at the time the temporary authority was granted continue to exist. It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the authority should be extended to December 31, 1945, the date to which extension of temporary authorities generally similar to that here involved was granted other public utility warehousemen at San Francisco.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the expiration date of the authority granted applicant by Decision No. 36961, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby extended to December 31, 1945, unless sooner changed, canceled or further extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
