BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across "Q" Street in Bakersfield, Kern County, at the location described in Application No. 26493, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-886.9-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign. (G. O. No. 75-B)

Said crossing serving the same purpose as that authorized in Decision No. 37315 in Application No. 26308, said Decision No. 37315 is rescinded and said Application No. 26308 is dismissed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or

safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
