**ORDER**

O. Vieux, owner and operator of a public utility water system furnishing domestic service to consumers located on the State Highway between Niles and Mission San Jose, asks the Commission for authority to transfer a portion of the system to Alameda County Water District, a public corporation, which joins in the application.

Mr. Vieux supplies water for domestic purposes to five consumers located along the State Highway. The water is pumped from a well into a tank located on his premises and thence distributed to the consumers through pipe lines installed on the Highway. He desires to sell the distribution mains and retain the well, tank and pipe lines on his property for his own use.

Alameda County Water District has its mains installed in the State Highway in front of the premises supplied by Mr. Vieux and has sufficient water supply and main capacity to provide the service and will serve these consumers. The District has also agreed to fulfill all public utility obligations of Mr. Vieux.

It appearing that this is not a matter on which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that O. Vieux be and he is hereby authorized to sell and transfer on or before April 1, 1945, a portion of his public utility water system to the Alameda County Water District, said sale to be made pursuant to the

terms and conditions of the Resolution of the Alameda County Water District  
attached to the application.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that, within thirty (30) days after the sale and transfer of a portion of his public utility water system to the Alameda County Water District, On Vieux shall file with the Railroad Commission of the State of California a statement showing the exact date when such transfer was effected, together with a copy of the deed by means of which he transferred said properties to the District.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that, concurrently with the sale and transfer of the portion of his public utility water properties to the Alameda County Water District, O. Vieux is relieved of the obligation to operate said properties as a public utility water system.

The authority herein granted shall become effective upon the date hereof.
