BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of the PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ON RELATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at grade of the State highway and the tracks of the Sacramento Northern Railway one mile north of Live Oak, in the County of Sutter, State of California.)

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Highway III Sut-3-A at grade across the main line of Sacramento Northern Railway near Live Oak, Sutter County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 8-149.6. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, including the cost of protection, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Sacramento Northern Railway shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than sixty feet and grades of approach not greater than one per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G. O. No. 75-3).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years from the end of the existing war, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
