BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Investigation by the Commission upon its own motion into rates, charges, rules, regulations, operations and practices of common carriers subject to the provisions of the Public Utilities Act relating to transportation of property to or from points on the lines of such common carriers on the one hand and to or from points on the lines of carriers not subject to the provisions of the Public Utilities Act on the other.

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This investigation, undertaken upon the Commission's own motion, involves the lawfulness and propriety of rates published by common carriers subject to the provisions of the Public Utilities Act for the transportation of property between points on their lines and points on the lines of carriers not subject to the provisions of that act. The investigation was instituted a number of years ago and a hearing then held. However, it now appears that a decision could not properly be rendered without a reopening of the matter for further hearing and argument, and that such a continuance of the investigation would not be justified at this time.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby dismissed.
