ORDER DISCONTINUING PROCEEDING

By order dated August 22, 1944, the Commission instituted an investigation upon its own motion into the intrastate operations in California of American Airlines, Inc., to determine whether said respondent should be ordered to file with the Commission its schedules of intrastate rates, fares, charges and classifications.

Respondent has now filed its Passenger Tariff No. 4, C.R.C. No. 1, to become effective February 1, 1945. The cause for investigation has been removed and the order instituting investigation should be vacated and the proceeding discontinued.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order instituting investigation in this proceeding be and it is hereby vacated and that this proceeding be and it is hereby discontinued.
