OPINION

The applicants, Mary Maritzen and E. B. Osthues, copartners doing business as The Modesto Transit Company, have
heretofore been authorized to operate a passenger stage service
between the corner of 11 and "I" Streets in the City of Modesto,
and the Modesto Municipal Airport, located outside the corporate
(1)
city limits of Modesto, a distance of approximately 2.6 miles.

By the present application, authority is sought to operate an additional service between the same termini but via a different route. It is alleged by applicants that operation over the proposed new route is urged by a large majority of the passengers now being served by applicants, particularly that portion of the public desiring transportation between their homes and places of employment, who are now required to walk several blocks to

reach the present line extending along La Loma Avenue, thence east and south.

The City Council of Modesto has passed a resolution approving the additional service. The area which it is proposed to serve is a built-up section just outside the city limits without convenient public transportation service.

From the facts of record it would appear that a need exists for the proposed additional routing and, accordingly, the application will be granted. A public hearing is not required. The route will be defined in the order as part of the service regulations.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that service regulation 3 on sheet 6 of the order in Decision No. 35411, dated May 26, 1942, in Application No. 24825, be amended by adding the following described route:

From 12th and "H" Streets, thence south on 12th Street to Grand Street; thence east on Grand Street to Yosemite Boulevard, also known as Waterford Road; thence east on Yosemite Boulevard to Santa Rosa Avenue, thence south on Santa Rosa Avenue to Mono Drive; thence east on Mono Drive to Empire Avenue, thence south on Empire Avenue to Tuolumne Avenue. Returning over the same route to 12th and "H" Streets:

Applicants may turn their motor vehicles at termini or intermediate points either in the intersection of the street or by operating in either direction around a block contiguous to such intersection.

In all other respects said Decision No. 35411 shall be and remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
