FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant is a highway contract and city carrier. He operates tank truck equipment for the transportation of fuel and road oil for Tide Water Associated Oil Company between specified points within and in the vicinity of Fresno. For reasons set forth in Decision No. 32710 of January 9, 1940, in this proceeding, as amended, he has been authorized to observe rates less than the minimum rates otherwise applicable to that transportation. This authority is scheduled to expire January 27, 1945. Its indefinite extension is now sought.

The verified petition discloses that there has been no material change in the operating conditions surrounding the transportation in question since this matter was last considered in January, 1944. It also discloses that during this time there has been no substantial change in applicant's costs.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that an extension of applicant's authority is justified. Because the conditions under which this service is

rendered may change at any time, the extension will be limited to a one-year period.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted W. F. Dunn by Decision No. 32710, as amended, in the above entitled application, be and it is hereby extended to January 27, 1946, unless sooner changed, canceled or further extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective January 27, 1945.
