SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER**ORIGINAL**

Under authority previously given in this proceeding California Central Railroad Company suspended service on its line of railroad in Santa Cruz and San Benito Counties on November 1, 1930. The Interstate Commerce Commission has now issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity in Finance Docket No. 14721 authorizing the abandonment of this railroad, and applicant requests a supplemental order from this Commission permitting abandonment and cancellation of all freight tariffs and circulars. Applicant's bridge across the Pajaro River has been destroyed by floods and the track materials have been removed and sold.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that California Central Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its entire line of railroad and to cancel all tariffs and schedules on file with this Commission.

This order shall become effective immediately.
