## ORDER

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across 19th Street at its intersection with "R" Street in Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 4-137.94-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B), which may be those now protecting the adjacent crossing of 19th Street with a Southern Pacific track (Crossing No. AH-91.05),

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be attended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
