ORDER

In this supplemental application Key System requests permission to discontinue street car operation on East 14th Street between 104th Avenue and 105th Avenue in the City of Oakland. Applicant alleges that due to congestion at this terminal of its street car line it has procured an off-the-street terminal on private property in the vicinity of 104th Avenue, and proposes to run its street cars into this off-the-street terminal.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Key System to abandon street car service on one block of East 14th Street from 104th Avenue to 105th Avenue in the City of Oakland, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Applicant shall give not less than ten (10) days' notice to the public of said abandonment of service by posting notices in its street cars and motor coaches operating along East 14th Street.
- (2) Said abandonment shall become effective concurrently with the establishment of an off-the-street railway terminal in the vicinity of 104th Avenue.
- (3) Applicant shall within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify the Commission, in writing, of the abandonment of service authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof.

- (4) The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
