EIGHTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant, for reasons set forth in Decision No. 32816, as amended, in this proceeding, has been authorized to observe rates lower than the established minimum rates for the transportation of coca cola from Fresno to specified San Joaquin Valley points for Coca Cola Bottling Company of Fresno. This authority will expire February 23, 1945. A one-year extension is now sought. The verified application discloses that there has been no material change in the conditions surrounding the transportation in question since this matter was last considered a year ago and that the rates involved continue to return a satisfactory profit.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the sought extension is justified.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted Fortier Transportation Company, a copartnership,

by Decision No. 32816 of February 13, 1940, as amended, in the above entitled application, be and it is hereby extended to February 23, 1946, unless sooner changed, canceled or further extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective February 23, 1945.
