BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The County of San Bernardino is authorized to construct a County Road at grade across the main line tracks of The Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company, near Barstow, San Bernardino county, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-750.2. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall not be less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Frotection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B).

Upon completion, Crossing No. 2-750.3, about 500 feet to the west, shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless

time be extended or if the above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,
necessity or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
