Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across portions of Parker Street and Eighth Street and across Carlton Street in Berkeley, Alameda County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified and protected as follows:

Portion of Parker St., as a portion of A-8.85-C, 1 Std. No. 1 Crossing Sign Portion of Eighth St. No identification or protection necessary. Carlton St., as Crossing No. A-9.0-C, 2 Std. No. 1 Crossing Signs

Applicant shell bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of . widths to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
