BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the construction at grade of an industrial spur track across Tujunga Avenue, in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of California.) Application No. 26557

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORIGINALORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Tujunga Avenue at Hewitt Station, City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application. Said avenue is not open or traveled at the point of crossing and this order shall not be construed as authorizing such opening. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
