ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This investigation was instituted by the Commission on its own motion January 16, 1940, at the time Interurban Electric Railway was seeking authority to abandon electric rail service and the other named carriers were applying for certificates to extend their passenger operations. The various problems presented were heard separately and seven Interim Opinions and Orders were issued, the last on October 27, 1942. All of the service matters involved were disposed of without closing the above entitled case. It appears, therefore, that this investigation on the Commission's own motion should be dismissed.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the above-entitled proceeding be and it hereby is dismissed.
