SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

For reasons set forth in Decision No. 30938, as amended, in this proceeding, Ira P. Lamb, a city and highway contract carrier, has been authorized to transport grain, grain products and related commodities for Sperry Flour Company (now General Mills, Inc.--Sperry Division), between points within specified territory in southern California. The authority provides for the observance of designated weekly or monthly vehicle-unit rates in lieu of per-shipment rates which would otherwise be applicable. This authority will expire March 11, 1945. Applicant seeks an extension thereof for an unspecified period of time.

The verified application discloses that no substantial change has occurred in the unusually favorable conditions surrounding this transportation and that operations under the authorized rates continue to be profitable.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that a further extension is justified. Due, however, to the possibility that the conditions under which this service is rendered may change at any time the extension will be limited to a period of one year.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Appendix "A" of Decision No. 30938 of May 31, 1938, as amended, in Application No. 21911, be and it is hereby further amended by substituting in Item No. 5 thereof "General Mills, Inc. - Sperry Division" in lieu of "Sperry Flour Company."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted Ira P. Lamb by said Decision No. 30938, as amended, be and it is hereby extended to March 11, 1946, unless sooner changed, canceled or further extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

In all other respects said Decision No. 30938, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective March 11, 1945.
