ORDER

Sacramento Northern Railway has requested authority to abandon its part-time agency at East Gridley in Butte County. In recent years applicant has maintained an agency at this point during the fruit shipping season of from a month to six (6) weeks during the months of July and August. In 1944 said agency was open from August 1 to August 31 and the total traffic moving to and from this point consisted of one carload of fruit, ten carloads of empty boxes, and six less-than-carload shipments, producing a total revenue of one hundred and ninety-six (\$196.00) dollars, of which the Sacramento Northern Railway's portion was sixty-five (\$65.00) dollars. California Farm Bureau Federation has been furnished a copy of the application and makes no objection to the proposed abandonment. It is apparent that there is little need for the further maintenance of an agency at this station and that the application should be granted, therefore,

Good Cause Appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Sacramento Northern Railway is authorized to abandon all agency service at East Gridley, Butte County, and to change its station records and tariffs accordingly, provided that said station be continued as a non-agency station for the receipt and delivery of carload and less-than-carload freight.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
