ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This proceeding is an investigation on the Commission's own motion for the purpose of establishing or approving just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory maximum rates, charges, classifications, rules and regulations to be charged, collected and observed by E. Guy Warren, doing business as Warren Transportation Company. The investigation was instituted upon request of the Office of Price Administration. After review of available data that office now advises that it is of the opinion that no good purpose would be served by continuing the proceeding and that it withdraws its objections to the rate increases involved herein. Under the circumstances the proceeding will be dismissed.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled proceeding be and it is hereby dismissed.
