In the Matter of the Application of DALE C. RAMSEY dba VALLEY TRUCK CO. for an extension of certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile truck service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of commodities generally, with certain exceptions, from Los Angeles Drayage Area to Imperial Valley territory; for the transportation of farm products and dairy products from all points and places within Imperial Valley territory to Los Angeles territory; for the transportation of dry ice from Imperial Valley territory to Los Angeles; and for the transportation of newspapers and newspaper supplements from Los Angeles, California, to Bloomington, Indio, Coachella, Thermal, Oasis and Calexico and all intermediate points between Bloomington and Calexico.


BY THE COMMISSION:
