
THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 35209 of March 31, 1942, as amended, in this proceeding, the Commission suspended until May 1, 1945 conditions Nos. 2 and 7 of its order in Decision No. 30790 (41 C.R.C. 239) in so far as they require applicant and The Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company to interchange tickets at common fares. This action was taken because subsequent to the issuance of Decision No. 30790, supra, the rail lines were permitted to increase their fares by 10 per cent (Decision No. 35007- 44 C.R.C. 26) and applicant did not wish to make a similar increase. Further suspension until May 1, 1946 is now sought for the same reason.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the further suspension requested should be authorized.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that conditions Nos. 2 and 7 of Decision No. 30790 of April 18, 1938, in Applications Nos. 20170, 20171, 20172 and 20173, be and they are hereby further suspended until May 1, 1946; and that appropriate amendments of applicant's tariffs be



filed on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
