In the matter of application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the construction at grade of railroad tracks upon and across 9th Street, in the City of Mendota, County of Fresno, State of California.)
Application No. 26606)

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct three side tracks and two crossover tracks at grade across 9th Street and to remove two existing tracks (1 siding, 1 spur) in Mendota, Fresno County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. BA-174.6. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B) now in place, but relocated to proper positions on right side of street. Nothing in this order shall be construed as authorizing the construction of a track in any manner contrary to our General Order No. 26-C.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or

safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
