## BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of Arvin Water Company, a corporation at Arvin, Kern County, California, for an order Authorizing the mortgage of its Physical Property.

**ORIGINAL**FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission by Decision No. 37618, dated January 16, 1945, authorized Arvin Water Company to issue a note for the principal sum of \$18,800, and execute a mortgage to secure the payment of said note and additional advances or loans of not exceeding \$6,200, if and when the issue of said additional advances or loans is authorized by the Railroad Commission.

Applicant asks permission to increase the face amount of the note from \$18,800 to \$23,242.92. It intends to expend the \$23,242.92 for the following purposes:

The Commission has considered applicant's request and is of the opinion that it should be granted. Therefore, it is ordered that paragraph one of the Order in Decision No. 37618, dated January 16, 1945, reading:

"1. Arvin Water Company may, after the effective date hereof and on or before June 30, 1945, issue its 5% promissory note in the principal sum of not exceeding \$18,800, said note to be in, or substantially in, the same form as the note on file in this application. Arvin Water Company shall use the proceeds realized through the issue of said note for the purposes set forth in the foregoing Opinion and more particularly described in this application."

be, and it is hereby amended to read:

1. Arvin Water Company may issue its 5% promissory note in the principal sum of not exceeding \$23,242.92, said note to be in, or substantially in, the same form as the note on file in this application. Arvin Water Company shall use the proceeds realized through the issue of said note for the purpose of paying the indebtedness and the cost of the improvements set forth in this First Supplemental Order.
