SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That service regulation 2 of the order of Decision No. 37478 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"2. Applicants shall comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, appropriate tariffs and time schedules on or before April 30, 1945, on not less than 1 day's notice to the Commission and the public."

(2) Said Decision No. 37478 shall in all other respects remain in full force and effect.
