OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant operates a public utility warehouse in Merced. She seeks authority to lease approximately one-half of the warehouse to Lawrence Warehouse Corporation for a period of one year.

According to the verified application the space to be leased is not expected to be required within the next year in the conduct of applicant's public utility business and is urgently needed by lessee for the accommodation of perishable army and navy stores.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Mirth Montgomery, doing business as Merced Elevator Company, be and she is hereby authorized to lease the warehouse space involved in the above entitled application to Lawrence Warehouse Corporation for a period of not more than one year.
