In the Matter of the Application of THE WESTERN PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY for permission to construct, operate and maintain a spur track at grade across the south half of Lindsay Street and across Lincoln Street south of Lindsay Street, in the City of Stockton, County of San Joaquin, State of California.

O R D E R

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across a portion of Lindsay Street and across Lincoln Street in Stockton, San Joaquin County, at the locations described in the application. Said streets are not opened to public travel at the point of crossing and this order shall not be deemed authority for such opening. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
