## ORDER OF DISKISSAL

The original application in this proceeding was filed February 11, 1941 and an amended application was filed on June 30, 1942. The matter involves the granting of a certificate of public convenience and necessity for passenger stage service between Bakersfield and Porterville and intermediate points, via Oildale and Ducor. The application was set down for public hearing on March 20, 1941, was reset to April 16 and temporarily removed from the calendar on March 31, 1941 at the request of applicant. The Commission has been advised by applicant that the new highway over which the proposed service was to be routed will not be completed until after the war.

No good cause therefor would be served by continuing this proceeding before the Commission as the matter will require the development of a new record to meet prevailing conditions.

Therefore, it appears that the above numbered application as amended should be dismissed with the understanding that such action will in no way prejudice the interest of the applicant in any future filing for the authority sought herein.

IT IS ORDERED that the above entitled proceeding be and it hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
