O R D E R

The verified application of The Western Pacific Railroad Company discloses that the amount of passenger and freight business transacted at applicant's station of Ludwig during the past year no longer warrants its continued maintenance.

Good Cause Appearing, The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Ludwig, County of San Joaquin; to remove spur track and other appurtenances at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
