In the Matter of Application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the construction at grade of two railroad spur tracks and one drill track across 7th Street and one railroad spur track and one drill track across North "B" Street in the County of Sacramento, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct two spur tracks and one drill track at grade across 7th Street and one spur track and one drill track at grade across North "B" Street in Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as follows:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Track</u>	<u>Crossing No.</u>
"B"	500' West of 10th	Drill	Portion of A-90.67-C
"B"	400' East of 7th	Spur	A-90.72-C
7th	1400' North of "B"	Spur	A-90.96-C
7th	2800' North of "B"	Spur	A-91.22-C
7th	South of Levee	Drill	A-91.32-C

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B), at each location.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time

be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Author-  
ization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity  
or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
