In the Matter of the Application of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, for authority to construct, maintain and operate a passing track at grade upon and across a county road at Porphyry, Riverside County, California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

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The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct one passing track at grade across a County Road at Porphyry, Riverside County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 2B-22.7. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four per cent. Existing protection of one Standard No. 1 crossing sign shall be supplemented by one additional Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one

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year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
