BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The County of San Bernardino is authorized to construct Victorville Access Road at grade across the spur track of the United States of America Railroad in the vicinity of Adelanto, San Bernardino County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-36.6-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance costs outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The United States of America Railroad shall bear maintenance costs between such lines. Width of crossing shall not be less than thirty-six feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not

complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
