BY THE COMMISSION:

O P I N I O N

In the above entitled proceeding Pacific Greyhound Lines, a corporation, requests the Commission to revoke a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing highway common carrier operations for the transportation of property between Sausalito, Bolinas and the Radio Corporation of America Wireless Station and intermediate points. Applicant would continue to provide service as a passenger stage corporation for the transportation of passengers and baggage and shipments of express weighing 100 pounds or less between the same points.

As justification for the revocation sought, applicant alleges as follows:

For a period in excess of a year applicant has not been requested to transport any freight of any kind whatsoever between any of the points included within said certificate to operate as a highway common carrier as defined in Section 2 3/4 of the Public Utilities Act. Applicant alleges that there is no purpose to be served in continuing said highway common carrier certificate in effect and applicant desires authority to abandon said operative right for the transportation of freight between all of the points covered by said highway common carrier certificate.

In our judgment the request for an order of revocation is justified in the application and should, therefore, be issued. This is not a matter requiring a public hearing.

O R D E R

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Pacific Greyhound Lines by Decisions Nos. 36712 and 36764, in Application No. 25647, authorizing operations as a highway common carrier, as defined in Section 2-3/4 of the Public Utilities Act, between Sausalito, Bolinas and Radio Corporation of America Wireless Station and intermediate points, is hereby revoked and annulled.

(2) That Pacific Greyhound Lines shall, within 30 days from the effective date hereof, and on not less than 5 days' notice to the Commission and the public, cancel tariffs and time tables which are applicable to the operative rights revoked.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days from the date hereof:
