O P I N I O N

Yosemite Park and Curry Co., a corporation, has requested the Commission to authorize it to suspend until December 31, 1946 its passenger stage service between Fresno and Yosemite National Park, and intermediate points, and between Lake Tahoe and Yosemite National Park, and intermediate points. The operative right for such service was defined by Decision No. 31396 in Application No. 21861 as Route B and Route C, respectively. Operation over these routes is provided seasonally. Over Route B it is between approximately May 1 and October 1, and over Route C between approximately July 1 and September 1 of each year. The only traffic which may be transported is that having point of origin or point of destination at Yosemite National Park.

The application states:

"That under regulations of the Office of Defense Transportation currently in effect, resumption of service on said routes would not now be permissible, and petitioner is advised that the National Park Service is agreeable to the continued suspension of operation of said routes."

After full consideration of applicant's request, we are of the opinion and so find that it is in the public interest that the application be granted for the current season only. If, in the

judgment of applicant, the same or comparable conditions prevail at the expiration of the authority granted, it may file a supplemental request for an extension of such authority. This does not appear to be a matter requiring a public hearing.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) That Yosemite Park and Curry Co. is hereby authorized to suspend for the 1945 calendar year season, operations over Route B between Fresno and Yosemite National Park, and intermediate points, and over Route C between Lake Tahoe and Yosemite National Park, and intermediate points, as such routes are defined in Decision No. 31396; provided that said service shall be resumed for the 1946 calendar year operation unless further suspension is authorized by the Commission, and, upon such resumption of service, appropriate tariffs and time tables shall be filed upon 10 days' notice to the Commission and the public.

(2) That Yosemite Park and Curry Co. shall comply with the Commission's General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing, in triplicate, amendments to its tariffs and time tables reflecting the authority herein granted within 30 days from the effective date hereof and upon not less than 1 day's notice to the Commission and the public.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
