OPINION AND ORDER.

Complainant charges that defendant Herington is operating as a highway common carrier of films and supplies between Los Angeles and theatres in Whittier, Montebello, and Belvedere Gardens without a certificate. The evidence adduced at the hearing discloses that defendant holds permits as a radial highway common carrier, a city carrier, and a highway contract carrier, and has delivered films and accessories to certain theatres in the cities mentioned. However, the record being insufficient to establish highway common carrier status, IT IS ORDERED that Case No. 4695 be and it is hereby dismissed.
