ORDER VACATING ORDERS OF SUSPENSION AND INVESTIGATION

By orders dated December 29, 1944, and March 27, 1945, the Commission suspended until June 28, 1945, the operation of Item No. 3 of Local and Joint Baggage Tariff No. 500-G, C.R.C. No. 5, of National Bus Traffic Association, Inc., Agent, and deferred the effective date of said tariff in so far as it purports to cancel comparable provisions presently in effect.

Suspension was ordered for the reason that the provisions of the aforesaid item would have resulted in unauthorized increases. Thereafter, respondent applied for and secured authority to establish these increases (63rd section authorization No. 18187 of April 17, 1945). The cause for suspension having been removed, our orders of December 29, 1944 and March 27, 1945, should be vacated and the proceeding discontinued.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the orders of suspension and investigation in this proceeding be and they are hereby vacated and the proceeding discontinued.
